special instruction, family training, assistive technology, social work, vision, psychological, and nutrition services. There are also specific types of medical health, nursing and transportation services.

- ☺ A family service coordinator is available to assist families with the evaluation and eligibility determination, IFSP development and service provision, including assistance to ease the transition to Part B Special Education Services when the child reaches age 3.

### Who is eligible for tiny-k services?

- ☺ All infants and toddlers, under 36 months, with disabilities and developmental delays are eligible for *tiny-k* services.

### How much does it cost the family?

- ☺ These services are provided at no charge to the family through the programs as described in Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
